Matthew 9:37-38</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Scripture Prayers for the Harvest</p> <p>Grab a friend and walk once a week. As you go, use these Scripture prayers to guide you as you pray together for the work the Lord wants to do in your community. God's Word is our only offensive spiritual weapon. When we use it in prayer we can be confident that we are praying in His will and that we will see Him move in power. What kind of revival might the Lord be waiting to do in your life, your church, your community? Invite Him in!</p>
<p>Lord, I pray also that the eyes of these people's hearts may be enlightened in order that they might know the hope to which You have called them, the riches of Your glorious inheritance, and Your incomparably great power for us who believe. Open their eyes to Your, Lord! Ephesians 1:18-19</p>	<p>Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. Matthew 9:37-38 Father we ask that you would multiply your workers, that every follower of Christ would truly heed Your call to be salt and light in a dark world. Father, we also ask that you would strengthen and protect those workers already diligently laboring in Your fields. Multiply their efforts. Show us how to take part in Your work for Your glory.</p>
<p>Lord, Your Word says that no one can come to You unless You draw him or her to Yourself (John 6:44). While this verse is full of potential questions, we just ask right now that You would draw these people to You, for Your name and Your glory. Lord, please draw them with Your love, Your kindness, Your truth, and mercy.</p>	<p>And we pray for us, too, that You may open a door for us to share the Gospel, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ and that we You would help us to proclaim it clearly. Colossians 4:3-4</p>
<p>Father, we ask that You would open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in You. Acts 26:18</p>	<p>Father, teach all of Your people to be wise in our interactions with those who do not yet know You so that we might make the most of every opportunity to be Your witnesses to others. Colossians 4:4</p>

Father, we ask that those here who do not know You yet might have softened hearts to receive Your gift of salvation. Just as You have made us fellow citizens with the saints and members of Your household, we ask that all these here would no longer be strangers and aliens but part of Your family as well.

Ephesians 2:19

Lord, we ask that Christ would dwell richly in each one of these hearts through faith and that each one would be rooted and grounded in Your love. Help all of Your people and those yet to belong to You to comprehend the height, depth, length and breadth of Your love which surpasses all knowledge. Fill Your people with the fullness of You! Ephesians 3:17-19

Lord, Your Word says that You desire all men to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth (1 Timothy 2:4). We pray in accordance with Your Word that You would rescue those who do not yet know You and that they would come to the knowledge of the truth.

Father, we ask that You would begin a good work in the lives of these people here that do not yet know You and that You would work in a tangible way in the lives of those who might have started a walk with You but have not pressed on to maturity. Father, You are faithful to finish the good work You started and we praise You for what You are going to do in these people's lives! Philippians 1:6

Lord, I thank You that You are able to immeasurably more than we could ask or even imagine! (Ephesians 3:20) We ask that You would do a work here that would just blow everyone's mind and bring You praise, honor and glory!

Father please reveal Your free gift of salvation to these people. Show them that it is by grace alone that they are saved, not of their own efforts to "be good" or "clean up" their lives. It is a free gift so that no one can boast (Ephesians 2:8-9). Reveal Your gift to them.

You command us to "love our neighbor as ourselves" Galatians 5:14. We are trying to fulfill that by praying for them. Please receive our service and do with it what pleases You. Show us more and more how to bring Your love into our homes and community.

Lord Jesus, Your Word says that if we ask in Your name it will be given to us (John 16:23). We are asking in Your name for a bountiful harvest of souls to wholeheartedly turn to You. We are asking for revival among those who have received Your truth and done little with it to grow. We are asking for a fiery passion to spring up in the hearts of all Your people to know You and love You with every breath.

<p>Lord, Your Word tells us that the effective prayers of the righteous can affect much, just like Elijah's praying for drought and then relief (James 5:16- 18). We ask that You would cleanse us from our sin so that nothing would hinder our prayers. We confess our pride, selfishness, and stubbornness. Cleanse us from all anger and arrogance. Give us clean hands and a clean heart to be Your tools.</p>	<p>Lord, many here are hurting. You are the God of all comfort. Please reveal Yourself to all these hurting hearts as the One and Only answer to their heart's need (2 Corinthians 1:3).</p>
<p>We pray Lord that we would be strong in Your mighty power. We ask that You would arm us with Your spiritual protection as we set out to pray for the harvest of souls. Put on our armor so that we might be able to stand firm against the enemy. Ephesians 6:10-11</p>	<p>But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8</p> <p>Father, demonstrate Your love to those who do not know You and those who have not grown in Your love in a real and fresh way today. Also, send reminders to them of the way in which You have already lavished them with love despite their sin. Thank You for revealing Your love to me.</p>
<p>Wrap us in Your truth, establish our lives in Your righteousness as a breastplate, protect our feet with the peace that comes from knowing Your Good News, give us big faith to act as a shield from all the fiery darts of the evil one and guard our minds with the knowledge of Your salvation. Finally, Father, give us a desire to know Your Word deeply so that our hands would always have a firm grip around Your Word which is our only offensive weapon. Keep us alert in prayer at all times for Your people.
